St. Mark, the Evangelist - April 25th

St. Mark, the Evangelist, is the author of the second Gospel and the patron saint of notaries. He wrote the Gospel in Greek for the Gentile converts to Christianity. Tradition says the Romans asked St. Mark to record the teachings of St. Peter about Jesus. St. Mark is often depicted as a winged lion in religious art. St. Mark is also said to have traveled with St. Paul and St. Barnabas, who was Mark's cousin, on their missionary journey through Cyprus. Mark is said to have founded the Church in Alexandria. St. Mark is sometimes called John Mark in the New Testament. Both he and his mother, Mary, were highly esteemed in the early Church, and his mother's house in Jerusalem served as a meeting place for Christians.

San Marcos Evangelista - 25 de abril

San Marcos, el evangelista, es el autor del segundo Evangelio y el santo patrón de los notarios. Escribió el Evangelio en griego para los gentiles conversos al cristianismo. La tradición dice que los romanos pidieron a San Marcos que registrara las enseñanzas de San Pedro sobre Jesús. San Marcos suele representarse como un león alado en el arte religioso. También se dice que San Marcos viajó con San Pablo y San Bernabé, que era primo de Marcos, en su viaje misionero por Chipre. Se dice que Marcos fundó la Iglesia en Alejandría. A San Marcos a veces se le llama Juan Marcos en el Nuevo Testamento. Tanto él como su madre, María, eran muy estimados en la Iglesia primitiva, y la casa de su madre en Jerusalén servía como lugar de reunión para los cristianos. www.cna.com

Perhaps we had already forgotten, or we have underestimated the great reality of our baptism, of the communion that we receive every day, or of the strength of our confirmation that resides indelibly in our souls: without a doubt, a seed of salvation that in some it generates fruits of His presence that "perfects us as the first fruits of eternal glory" (CCC # 1832). Love, joy, peace, patience, magnanimity, kindness, goodness, meekness, fidelity, modesty, temperance, and chastity are fruits of the presence of God in us that "drive us to assume our mission of being witnesses of the gospel by the way of the world" (BXVI). In the celebration of the sacraments, both for children and adults, at the Easter Vigil we have remembered that through these visible signs "we receive with increasing abundance the treasures of divine life and advance towards the perfection of charity" (CCC #1212), where through the grace of Christ our life is generated, grows, and sustains. Congratulations to all the newly baptized, confirmed and those who have received full communion through the sacraments of Christian initiation, and congratulations once again to those of us who belong to the great family of sons and daughters of God who for His love and mercy we enjoy and have enjoyed the abundance of God's presence in our lives. It is also our turn today to resume our commitment to pray and share with and for all those brothers who, distanced from the Church, have distanced themselves, due to confusion, from the means of salvation = sacraments instituted by Christ in their lives. And if you have a family member, son or daughter who is missing a sacrament of Christian initiation, begin to do your work of giving testimony and praying so that we all achieve the promised salvation. Remember, never forget, that every day is our Easter and that we are always full of the One who is the Life. Happy Easter in the Lord.
